

Weeks 7-11 - Safe 'Responsible for my body'

In weeks 7-11 of this term the PBL focus is safe and students being responsible for their bodies. Explicit lessons are being taught in classrooms including following a 1,2,3 and complex instruction, waiting for a cue and purposefully acting with the intention of a specific result. This can be demonstrated in classroom activities, sport, work crews, following instructions and using equipment safely e.g. in the playground or using scissors in the classroom. PBL tickets are given out to students being responsible for their bodies.

- Linking Medicare to myGov
- Downloading the Medicare Express Plus
- How to access your COVID-19 digital certificate and international COVID-19 Vaccination Certificate
- Add your COVID-19 digital certificate to your digital wallet
- Proof of vaccination if you are not eligible for Medicare

How to access proof of COVID-19 vaccination before the event:

Ask a vaccination provider to print a copy from the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) site Call the AIR general enquiries line on 1800 653 809 to ask for a copy to be mailed to you – Note: This can take up to 14 days to arrive Visit a Services Australia service centre

Please note: as per the current NSW Public Health Orders, all visitors to the venues aged 16yrs and over are required to:

- Be fully vaccinated or medically exempt
- Check-in upon arrival
- Wear a mask when indoors
- Follow social distancing rules
