

In weeks 7-10 of this term the PBL focus is safe and students using their bodies in the right way. Explicit lessons are being taught in classrooms including following a 1,2,3 or complex instruction, pointing to or at an object and making a choice between 2, 3 or an array. Students can demonstrate safe use of their bodies in classroom activities, sport, hydrotherapy, work crews and transitions. PBL tickets are given out to students using their bodies in the right way.


